Update: Implementation of SOLAS Requirement for Container Weight Verification

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As per the 2nd announcement on 09/May/2016, with effect from 1 July 2016, the International Maritime Organization (IMO) will start enforcing the Safety of Life at Sea Convention (SOLAS) that requires shippers to provide a Verified Gross Mass (VGM) per container.

The VGM is the certified Gross Mass of container (including weight of all cargoes, packing material, dunnage & container tare weight). There are two methods for the Shipper to calculate the VGM;

Method 1, weigh the packed container by using approved weighing scale

Method 2, weigh all packages and cargo items individually, incl. mass of dunnage, packing and securing material and add to tare weight of the container

In order to comply with the regulation, shippers are required to complete and submit VGM on and before VGM cut-off date/time. Hence, for shipment(s) loading date on or after 1 July 2016 from the origin port of loading, our customer(s) are requested to submit 'Ensign VGM Declaration form' (as appendix).
