Update On Three Gorges Dam Congestion Caused by Annual Maintenance in China

Regarding to previous announcement on 24 February 2017, please find the latest situation of Three Gorges Dam updated by the government. The northern ship lock of the Yangtze River's Three Gorges Dam has resumed traffic on 14 March 2017 after annual maintenance.

However, the impact of the feeder transportation to/from West China is still being affected. Numerous ships are accumulated in the vicinity of the dam and waited to pass through Three Gorges Dam. Thus, transit time (around 13 days) by feeder ex. Chongqing to Shanghai will gradually resume normal after 1 April 2017.
