<u>Update – U.S. Custom and Border Protection (CBP) Extends In-Bond Regulatory</u>

**Enforcement Dates** 

Regarding to previous announcement on 30 December 2017 – requirement of indicating 6-digit

level Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States number (HTSUS) for In-Bond shipment.

Recently, U.S. Custom and Border Protection (CBP) has newly announced on 4 January 2018, the

implementation will be extended by six months until 2 July 2018.

Failure to comply may result in penalty enforced by CBP and unnecessary delay to your

shipment. After 2 July 2018, US CBP may issue penalties for missing HTS codes on In-Bond

shipments and/or reject the in-bond request until the HTS code is provided.

In additions, the date for the implementation of the provision requiring the 6-digit HTSUS

requirement for Immediate Transportation movements has not been set. However, customers are

recommended to submit HTS commodity code for all IPI / Inland shipments on Bill of Lading.
